» Workshop goals:

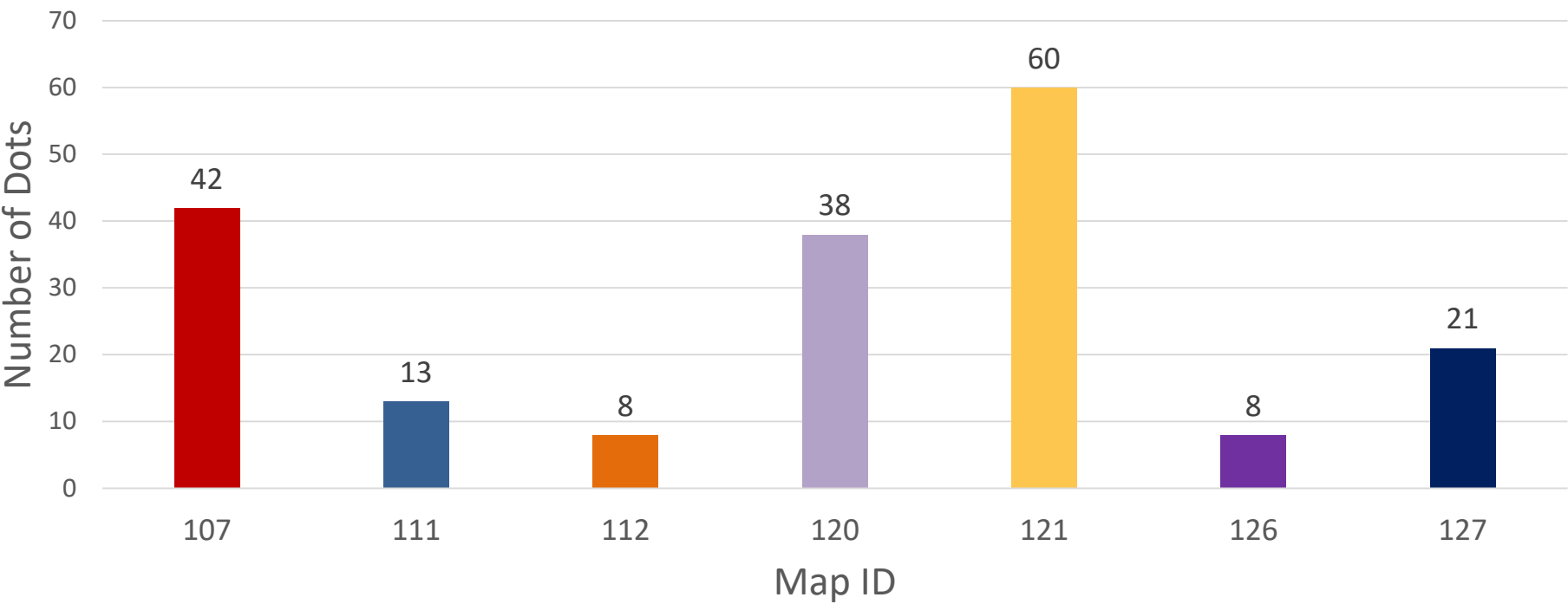
- Educate residents on the legal requirements and other parameters to create District maps

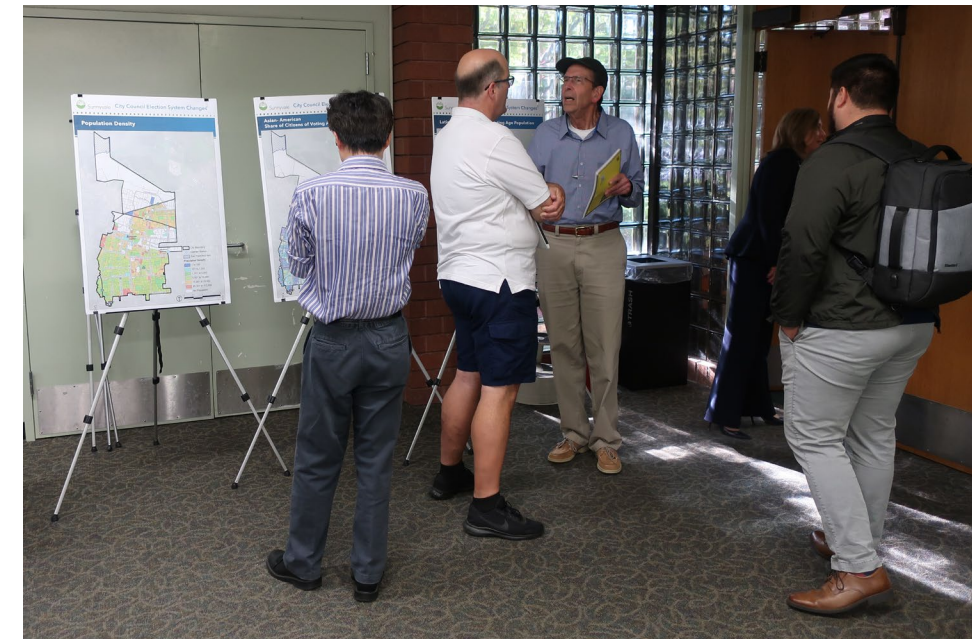

 - Ask the community to prioritize their top 3 maps

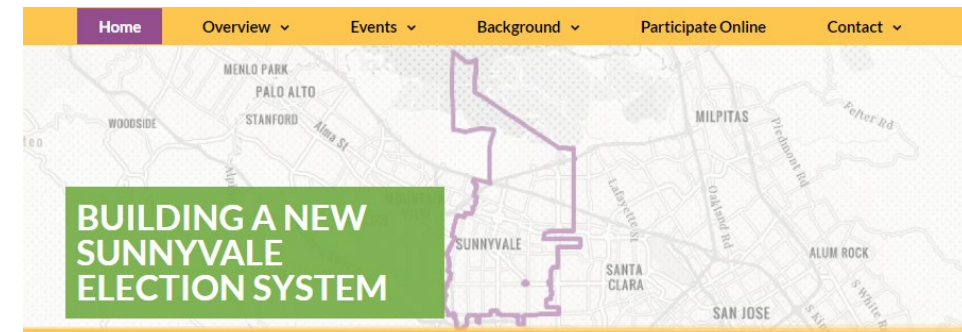
