Transportation Demand Management Program Summary

925 S. Wolfe Road, Sunnyvale

This is a summary of SummerHill's proposed 128-unit townhome project at 925 S. Wolfe Road. The draft Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Program achieves 10 points as required.

Proximity 5 Points—Less than an 0.5 miles to a major transit stop (two routes @ 15-minute headway). The nearest major transit stop is 0.3 miles away at El Camino Real and Wolfe Road. This stop serves VTA Route 522 and VTA Route 22.

Proximity to Commercial Uses 3 Points—Less than 0.25 miles from a shopping center with at least three tenant spaces. The project is 0.22 miles from the Hacienda Shopping Center on El Camino Real via Bellomo Avenue and Maria Lane.

Bicycle Facilities 0.5 Points—Provide an on-site bicycle repair station and secured bicycle parking. The project will provide a repair station at its clubhouse facility. Each unit in the project has a secure parking area in its garage for at least one bike.

Wayfinding Station 0.5 Points—*Onsite kiosk or information center with multi-modal wayfinding information and transit information.* An onsite kiosk/information center with wayfinding and transit information will be provided near the clubhouse facility.

TDM Communication 0.5 Points—Distribution of transit, wayfinding and other TDM informational materials to new residents as they move in and annually to all residents. The Homeowner's Association will distribute transit, wayfinding and other TDM informational materials to new residents as they move in and annually to all residents.

Proximity to Car Share 0.5 Points—*Less than 0.5 miles from a car share hub with cars available to on-site residents.* A car share site is located 0.4 miles from the project site.
