Arborist Memorandum for 802 W El Camino Real

Dear Ms. Behzadiaria,

Per your request, we are furnishing this memo regarding the proposed removal of an existing, approximate 12" Monterey pine (*Pinus radiata*), located near the vehicular entry in the back parking area of the site (outside the City's Right-of-Way).

Based on a visual inspection of the tree, I recommend removal based on the following:

- Tree retains a significant lean over the driveway and parking area
- Monterey pines, often Shallow rooted, are prone to blowing over
- When planted outside the coastal environment of Monterey, the species is subject to numerous pests and diseases

It is my opinion that the site would be better suited with removal and replacement with a more appropriate species.
