□ Three at South End; two vertical districts north of 101; one central-west district: 113, 118, 119




113 and 118 bring all districts together downtown along Washington.






□ Three at South End; United north of 101; two vertical central districts: 117, 120, 121, 123







□ Three at South End; United north of 101; two non-vertical central districts: 107, 122, 127









□ South has two stacked and one vertical; split north of Hwy 101: 101 and 114








□ South has two stacked and one vertical; united north of Hwy 101: 105, 126






Suggested: Choose Maps for Refinement
