Art in Public Places Program (Council Policy 6.4.4)

- Public art required on municipal projects over \$1,000,000
- 1% of the project valuation required
- Most recent public art project: Murphy Park Renovation in 2015




Art in Public Places Process

- Selection committee convened to review and develop short list of artists (2-5)
- Preliminary design concepts developed
- Arts Commission review and ranking/recommendation
- City Council review and approval






Fair Oaks Park - Castle Structure - View 2









