



Unspent Funds – Last 5 Years

 - Pakistani American Culture Center, Basant Kite Flying Festival, canceled (\$1,500 grant)
- FY 16/17 \$1,494
 - Crosswalk Community Church, The Hunt Event, declined based upon condition of removing prayer and bible activities (\$1,000 grant)
 - Pakistani American Culture Center, Basant Kite Flying Festival, canceled (\$1,000 grant)
 - Note: Evelyn Glen and Hazelhead Group received additional Council setaside funding of \$900
