## **Project Background**

- Fair Oaks Park
  - 15-acre park, built in 1969
  - "Old English" Park theme
  - Major renovation needed to ensure future sustainability
  - Addition of an "All inclusive" Magical Bridge Playground
  - City's first synthetic sports fields





## **Environmental Review**

- California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determination:
  - Class I Categorical Exemption
- Based on:
  - The proposed site improvements
  - Phase I Environmental Site Assessment
  - Geotechnical Investigation



# Cost Saving Measures Taken and Proposed

Reductions and removal of items were incorporated into the final design to address budget constraints.

#### Fair Oaks Park

- ✓ Fencing/gates, picnic tables
- Bleacher structures
- ✓ Scoreboards
- Change of: lighting product, surfacing
- Baseball/softball backstops
- Filming platforms
- Reuse bleachers

#### Magical Bridge Playground

- ✓ Number of swings
- ✓ Number of retreat huts
- ✓ Half ball climbers (removed)
- Playhouse simplification

## **Construction Bidding**

- Four Bids Received on June 3, 2020
- Engineer's Estimate: \$14,550,000
- Lowest Bid:

Robert A. Bothman Construction:Magical Bridge Item: \$4,000,000Park Renovation:\$12,300,000Total Base Bid:\$16,300,000(No Bid Alts are Recommended)

- Low bid is 9.7% and \$1.5M lower than next two bids
- Rebidding is unlikely to result in lower prices without major scope reductions





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## Magical Bridge Foundation Consultant Services Agreement Amendment #2


The Magical Bridge Foundation met the fundraising goal for the project. Bids exceeded the target budget amount so a budget modification is needed to fully fund construction.

#### **Action Needed**

Authorize the City Manager to execute a Second Amendment to a Consultant Services Agreement to a new not-to-exceed amount of \$2,301,500 with Magical Bridge Foundation Request from the Park Dedication Fund


\$3,399,392 includes standard 10% contingency

- \$242,850 to All-Inclusive Playground (832870)
- \$3,156,542 to Fair Oaks Park Renovation (830340)



### Recommendations

- Award a construction contract in the amount of \$16,330,000 to Robert A. Bothman Construction with a 10% construction contingency
- Make a finding of CEQA Categorical Exemption
- Approve second amendment to consultant services agreement with Magical Bridge Foundation
- Approval of Budget Modification No. 6
