Current Options

Viewing City meetings online



- Surveyed all Santa Clara County cities
- Inquired with 3,500-member Government Social Media Facebook group
- Reviewed findings from San Jose's Civic Engagement through Technology Pilot
- Drew on Sunnyvale's experience

For streaming government meetings:

- Most cities use and prefer YouTube
- Disadvantages outweigh advantages for using Facebook Live

Findings: Platform Use

Most cities in Santa Clara County use YouTube

Findings: Comments & Staff Support


- Facebook comments cannot be turned off
 - Risks: phishing attacks, inappropriate content
 - Decision: Monitor comments or not


- FB Live requires additional staff support
 - Comment monitoring
 - Technical issues

Findings: Community Engagement

 In San Jose, reach quickly dropped

- Facebook inflates views
 - Autoplay
 - View = 3+ seconds



Users prefer engaging, personal content on Facebook

Findings: YouTube Favors Long-Format Video



YouTube Better for City Meetings

YouTube

- Optimized for video
- Good video archiving

Facebook

- Optimized for social interaction
- Two-way communication

Users Prefer YouTube for Long-Format Video

Sunnyvale Nextdoor users preferred YouTube over Facebook 2.5 times to 1 for State of the City

YouTube best for streaming City meetings

Recommendation: No Pilot Needed

- 1. City is already successfully using YouTube, Granicus, and Zoom
- 2. Many agencies validated the challenges associated with Facebook Live and prefer YouTube
- 3. Our data shows users will not engage with this type of content on Facebook
- 4. Downside risks outweigh potential for increased engagement
