



### Site Plan





- Track Hard Costs through estimating and design decision making
- Track Soft Costs for efficiencies

### • Strategies for Managing Hard Costs

- Additive Alternates (not included in estimated base costs)
  - Operable Partition (1)
- Value Design/Engineering (potential ideas to achieve budget alignment)
  - Reduce Building Height
  - Simplify High Roof Ceiling
  - Simplify Technology Equipment
  - Others (Interiors/Finishes)


