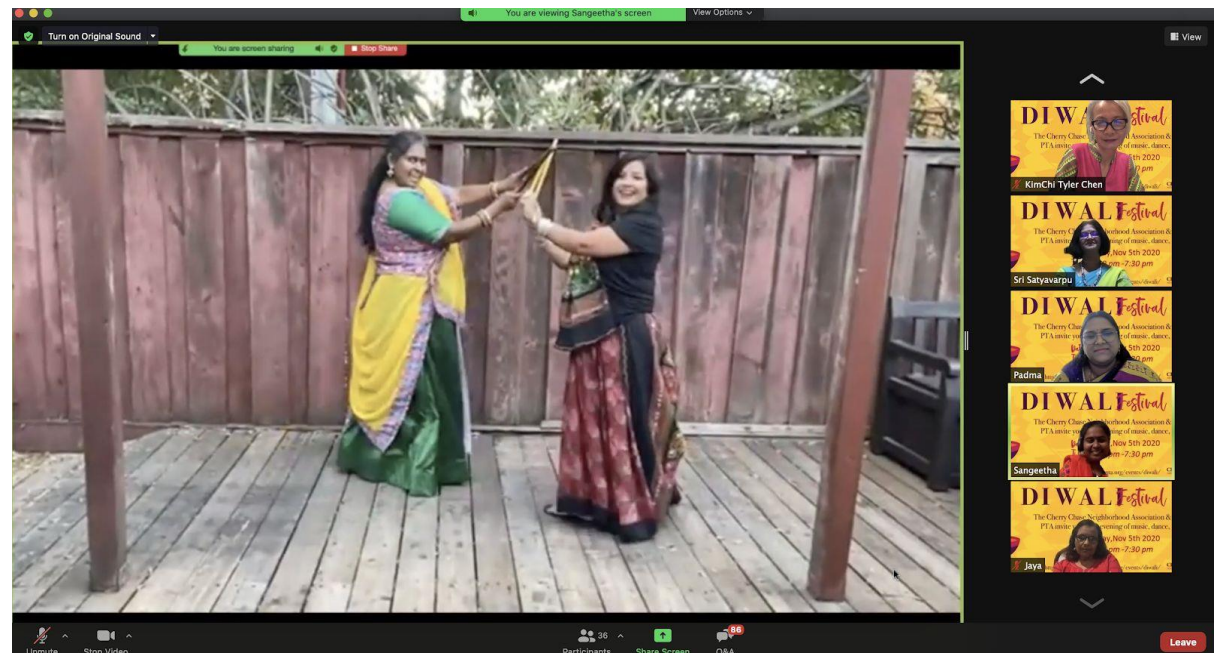

- Funding cap for Neighborhood Grants was increased from \$1,000 to \$1,500
