at 1.1%



Process for Project Approval


- Establish and prioritize projects list
- Council approval for funding
- Request for Qualifications
- Community Input & Project Committee
- Criteria
 - Projects aligning with community priorities
 - Alignment with guiding principles (general plan)
 - Alignment with Sunnyvale's community vision






Other Projects and Misc. Updates


- Utility Box Art RFQ distribution Sept/Oct 2021, expected installation Mar/Apr 2022
