FY 20/21 Planned Projects

Project Title	Project Activity Description
SRTS Incentives	Purchase incentives to distribute to students to encourage students to walk or roll to school
Banners for Schools	Create Walk and Roll encouragement banner for Sunnyvale schools to increase awareness of the SRTS program
Develop a strategic outreach plan for Vision Zero Campaign	Hire a consultant to develop a strategic and comprehensive marketing outreach plan to serve as a future roadmap, focusing on safety for bicyclists and pedestrian.
