Assistant Director Andrew Miner reminded the Commissioners to submit study issue ideas in order to agendize for discussion at a future meeting.

Chair Howard opened the Public Hearing.

Richard Mehlinger, Chair of the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission speaking on his own behalf, suggested a study issue idea that explores increasing density in the R-2 zones and using number of bedrooms or Floor Area Ratio to calculate density in R-2 and R-3 zones.

## **NON-AGENDA ITEMS AND COMMENTS**

#### -Commissioner Comments

Commissioner Howe asked staff to follow up at a future meeting with information about what role the Commission can play in reviewing wireless telecommunication facilities for sustainability during disasters.

Commissioner Weiss asked staff it the Commission will convene for a special meeting on December 16, 2019. Assistant Director Andrew Miner stated that the Environmental Impact Reports for the Downtown Specific Plan and the proposed project at 360 Caribbean Drive are tentatively scheduled to be heard on December 9, 2019 and December 16, 2019, respectively.

#### -Staff Comments

Assistant Director Andrew Miner stated that on November 5, 2019 the City Council adopted the 2019 California Building Code with local amendments and voiced support for the local Reach Codes initiative. He added that on November 12, 2019 a City Council Study Session will take place on Reach Codes and the Green Building

Program and the City Council will consider adopting an ordinance to prohibit by-right residential uses in non-residential zones.
