BACKGROUND

The application deadline was August 30, 2019. The deadline serves as a cutoff point to allow time to verify voter registration and schedule interviews.

EXISTING POLICY

Council Policy 7.2.19 Boards and Commissions and Administrative Policy Manual Chapter 1 - General Management Article 15

DISCUSSION

The City received 14 applications for current vacancies on Boards and Commissions. Seven applicants are scheduled to be interviewed on September 24, 2019. Five applicants were interviewed on September 10, 2019. Appointments to Boards and Commissions are scheduled for October 8, 2019. Rahul Jain has not confirmed availability to interview. Rahul Jain applied for the Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Commission (1st preference) and the Parks and Recreation Commission (2nd preference).

Lauren DeCarlo submitted an application for the Parks and Recreation Commission on September 12, 2019. Daniel McCune resigned from the Parks and Recreation Commission on September 11, 2019, resulting in a total of 2 vacancies on the Parks and Recreation Commission.
