<u>SUBJECT</u>

Consider Conditional Funding Awards for \$26 Million in Housing Mitigation Funds, Below Market Rate In-Lieu Funds, and Low Mod Income Housing Asset Funds for Development and/or Rehabilitation of Three Affordable Housing Developments

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Alternative 1: Award conditional funding commitments to the projects listed in Attachment 3 to the report.

Due to the high quality and need of all three applications, and the opportunity to add these exceptional new developments to the City's affordable housing inventory, Staff is recommending the City Council award conditional funding recommendations to the three applicants, outlined in Attachment 3. Any funding awarded used for land acquisition does not mean the Council approves any specific development project, unit mix, or architectural design of the preliminary project shown in the application on the acquired land. Any project funded using these funds are still required to undergo environmental review, obtain planning entitlements, and building permits prior to construction.
