City staff's recommendation is Alternative 1: Adopt the Roadway Safety Plan. The Roadway Safety Plan will satisfy the requirements of the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) Cycle 11 Call-for-projects to be released approximately April 2022. The plan will allow the City to be eligible to apply for federal HSIP funds.
